About

Overview

In March 2026, **China** exported \$9.37B and imported \$12.8B from **Russia**, resulting in a negative trade balance of \$3.39B. Between March 2025 and March 2026 the exports of **China** increased by \$1.6B (20.6%) from \$7.77B to \$9.37B, while imports increased by \$2.09B (19.6%) from \$10.7B to \$12.8B.

Trade

In March 2026, the top exports of **China** to **Russia** were **Cars** (\$1.11B), **Articles of low value in simplified customs procedures** (\$707M), and **Telephones** (\$261M). In the same month, the main imports of **China** from **Russia** were **Crude Petroleum** (\$5.32B), **Petroleum Gas** (\$1.01B), and **Refined Petroleum** (\$732M).

Growth

In March 2026, the year-on-year growth in **China's** exports to **Russia** was driven mainly by exports of **Cars** (\$504M or 83.3%), **Broadcasting Equipment** (\$52.9M or 370%), and **Computers** (\$49.7M or 30.6%). Meanwhile, in the same month, the rise in **China's** imports from **Russia** was mainly attributed to imports of **Crude Petroleum** (\$698M or 15.1%), **Copper Ore** (\$404M or 199%), and **Refined Petroleum** (\$339M or 86.4%).

In January 2022, **Russia** exported \$5.8B to **China**, marking a 31.6% increase from January 2021, when trade amounted to \$4.41B.

This chart compares trade between **China** and **Russia**, considering products traded by both at HS4 level.

During 2024, the top exports from **China** to **Russia** were **Cars** (\$15.2B), **Telephones** (\$4.2B), and **Computers** (\$3.17B).

On the other hand, the top exports from **Russia** to **China** were **Crude Petroleum** (\$62.6B), **Petroleum Gas** (\$13.2B), and **Coal, Briquettes and Similar Manufactured Solid Fuels** (\$10.5B).
